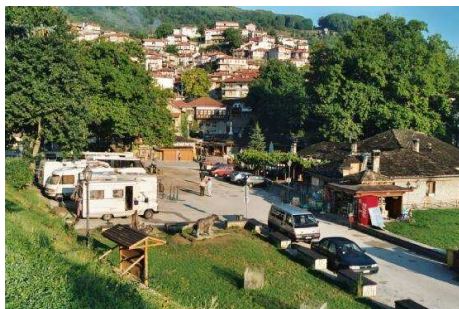

## Campings

For overnight stays on campings the rates are approximately the same as in e.g. France. Campings are often fun, especially the ones run by families. State owned campings (EOT Campings) are sometimes businesslike and not very well maintained. Camping guides will provide details on facilities, directions etc. A recent guide as well as maps will be with the camper. Again, some research on the Internet will provide lots of information.

## Free Camping



Greece is one of the few countries where free camping is generally tolerated. Going around the country by camper is still something fairly uncommon and not done by many Greek people. Because of the distances involved in coming from Europe, there are not that many campers on the roads and therefore they are not seen as a problem and

usually allowed to stay wherever they want (within reason). There are numerous bays, beaches and forest areas where this is possible and frequently done.

Of course the laws are the same as in the rest of Europe, but in Greece things are done differently ! We are not aware of any of our customers over the past 4 years having had a problem with the police or other authorities.

Of course if you are asked to leave a particular spot, that is not the moment to argue. Generally this is a non-issue.

## Official parking areas



There are quite a few official parking areas (recognized by large **P**-signs) where you can stay overnight. These areas often have shower and W.C. facilities.

Showers are usually available on beaches.

By law, Tavernas and Restaurants must provide public toilets.

## How to reach us ?

We are located on the island of Aegina, approximately an hour by car ferry from Athens/Piraeus.

The island is approx. half an hour by ferry from the Peloponese. This way you can avoid driving in the Athens area, where the traffic is often chaotic, on your way to the Peloponese.

The Peloponese is where most of our guests start and spend their vacation, with sometimes trips to Delphi and the mainland of Greece. This all depends on the time you have available of course.

Once at Athens airport, you take the 96 express bus to Piraeus harbour. Buy a ticket (€ 3,20) before boarding. At the harbour, the second last stop, you get off the bus and walk across towards the ferries.

You have the option of taking the fast Flying Dolphin or one of the regular car ferries. The difference in time is about ½ hour, in price: € 14,50 vs. € 8,50.

In Piraeus call Aad in Aegina to arrange pick up of the camper. Most of our guests spend their first night on the island of Aegina.
